WHEN QUALITY MATTERS

Javelin Recessed has been through value engineering to reduce construction and material costs. This new version changes from the original in various ways:

1. The gear pods located on the rear of the fitting, either side of the lamp reflector assembly, have been removed. Now all the control gear (including emergency inverter and batteries) are fixed integral within the body.
2. The various slide-out support brackets have been superseded by a push-out, adjustable, suspension tab system (not required on lay-in version).
3. Ceilings types covered by the Javelin Recessed range are: T15/24/Flush & Tegular, BURGESS H4 Spring Tee – as per catalogue.
4. Lamp options covered by range are: 3 & 4 lamp, 14w & 28w T5.
5. The canopy & bezel are now assembled before painting, then painted RAL9010.
6. The luminaire is visually identical to the current catalogue Javelin Recessed from below.
7. The new version utilises same louvre as the original and therefore regains the same photometric properties.
8. All options currently listed in the Whitecroft catalogue are available.
9. The recessed canopy depth remains as per the current Javelin Recessed i.e. 54mm on lay in T15/24 version (145mm for installation). The depth of the Tegular version is slightly deeper - 60mm (60mm for installation) & Spring Tee 63mm (75mm for installation) due to brackets.
