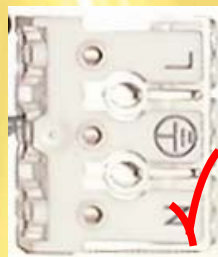

Oasis Mains Wiring

(Release date: Currently in production)

Summary: Mains power drop & through wiring for Oasis luminaire is now provided by installing contractor. The modifications bring Oasis in line with similar Merlin and Vista products.

The mains wiring method for the Oasis suspended luminaire has been revised. The pre-wired 3-core power feed with connector has been taken out of the product and replaced with piano key type mains terminal blocks. The use of the new terminals facilitates the use of only one power drop per continuous run of luminaires and provides the ability for mains through wiring by the customer.



Compass Junior

(Release date: January 21st)

Summary: Power to the Compass Junior head unit from its gearbox is now hard wired and strain relief provided off the back of the head assembly. Mains connection continues to be by Wieland gearbox mounted plug and socket (supplied).

The following changes apply to the connection of the head unit to its gearbox in the ceiling:

1. The Compass Junior was previously manufactured with a plug & socket arrangement connecting the head to the gearbox. This is now hard wired and comes complete as a one-piece head & gear assembly.
2. The head unit was previously manufactured with an up-stand attached to the back of the bezel. This up-stand provided the cable strain relief for the wiring between the head unit and gearbox. The strain relief is now provided by cable clamp on the back of the reflector head assembly.
