While newly constructed buildings are undoubtedly more energy efficient, the upfront carbon cost associated with construction is high.

By focussing our efforts on the decarbonisation of our existing buildings, 80% of which are estimated to still be in operation in 2050, we can make significant


operational carbon savings as well as conserving the original embodied carbon associated with the building's construction.


